## **Guidance Notes and Rules for Practice**

Following the Government's announcement and upon advice from the British Radio Car Association (BRCA), outside race tracks can be open subject to certain conditions as outlined below (these are subject to change at short notice).

Herts Nitro Model Club tracks are open for use by members and non-members.

All drivers are expected to observe the conditions below at all times and in using the tracks, agree to comply with these.

HNMC reserve the right to remove individuals and / or withdraw the membership of anyone not complying, which also could result in closure of the tracks.

- Persons that are self-isolating/have any of the symptoms of Covid-19, as outlined by the Department of Health, MUST NOT use the tracks.
- Activity should be in line with the Government's advised social distancing measures at all times. Remain 2 metres from others (except if from the same household) including when arriving to and departing from the track.
- Activity should only take place where travel to and from the track is in line with government advice.
- Face coverings are compulsory for everyone at all times while on site. They should only be removed temporarily to eat or drink
- Only ONE weekend track booking session may be held at any one time.
- We recommend gloves and use of hand sanitiser. Please be aware of using alcoholic hand sanitiser with warm engines etcetera.
- Pit crews and spectators please email race@hnmc.co.uk to book them in. This is for Track and Trace.
- Please use own gazebo or pit at car wherever possible. For covered pits please use only the designated pitting areas – choose a position and remain at it for the whole session. The pitting areas have been marked out.
- There should be no more than 12 drivers using the 8<sup>th</sup> rostrum. Use the one way system to enter and exit the rostrum.

- There should be no more than 6 drivers using the 10<sup>th</sup> rostrum. Each driver to stand at a designated position.
- There should be no more than 6 drivers using the crawler course.
- There should be no more than 4 drivers using the bash rostrum.
- For juniors who require adult supervision book and pay for the junior online then please inform race@hnmc.co.uk of the guardian's details.
- NO sharing of transmitters or other equipment; members must bring their own equipment. NO giving of spares to other members.
- No refreshments are allowed on the rostrums. Members should leave these within their designated pitting area.
- Closure of and no access to the indoor pit room.
- Upon arrival please park your vehicle at a respectful distance away from other people's parked vehicles.
- There should be no form of physical contact, e.g., shaking of hands, etc.
- Cars need to be self-marshalled, marshalled by a member of the same household or by an individual wearing protective work gloves.
- No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

Please observe these conditions at all times. These are subject to change in line with government and BRCA advice at short or no notice
