He wanted the sport to be accessible to all, young up and coming talent was to be nurtured. Along the way he influenced so many racers including UK and European champions Elliott Boots and Darren Bloomfield. All of them would agree he had a massive impact on their racing and experiences in RC. He did all that silently behind the scenes making no noises about it, passing on his knowledge he had built up over the vast years racing.

Karl was a very proud member of the HNMC committee, and was part of the team that helped deliver a very successful euro b championship in 2015. Following on from this, Karl was keen to bring another European championship back to HNMC, and was an influential voice to convince the club that the 40+ was the perfect fit.

Karl would have loved to see that a Euros was back at HNMC, it's just so sad that he didn't get to see it for himself.

7. The Track



Track size is approximately 60 metres x 45 metres with a modular layout. The track is run anti-clockwise and the surface consists of dirt, concrete, paving stones and Astro-turf. Lap times are 39-44 seconds depending upon layout.

8. Rostrum



Space for 15 drivers. One way system for entry and exit.

9. Marshalling



10. Pitting



A fixed under cover area for 70 Drivers with benches and 240v power.

The power is connected to with a UK three-pin rectangular blade (Type G) electrical plug that has a protective fuse inside.



With Marquee and Gazebo, we can fit 150 drivers within this area.



11. Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be located next to the pit lane exit. An obvious location for drivers to remember to put their cars in whilst also making it a quick and efficient dropoff / collection location.

13. Camping




Camping passes allocated at the registration area

Event Control Tyre Regulations

To ensure a fair and consistent racing environment, the following controlled tyre rules will apply for the Masters 40+ class:

Official Race Tyre -

Brand & Model: Jetko J-Zero Composite Super Soft

Product Code: JK1008CSSRW

Price: £33 per set

Availability: Trackside only (pre-glued from same batch, with identical rims & inserts)

Tyre Purchase & Allocation Rules

Minimum Required Purchase:

▶ 3 marked sets (must be purchased to participate)

Maximum Order Allowance:

► 4 marked sets

Additional Tyre Allocation:

► 1 extra marked set per bump-up, including exhibition finals

During Friday Practice any tyres may be used.

All tyres will be pre-glued by the manufacturer.

Monitoring & Compliance

Tyre usage will be monitored by race officials throughout the event.

Only tyres purchased through the official channel may be used for racing.

No modifications or substitutions are permitted.
